

Radiology and Diagnostic Test Record

Keep a record of any radiology studies or diagnostic tests, such as MRI, CT scan, bronchoscopy, etc. Keep track of where and when the test was done and a short description of the results. When having radiology tests, ask for a copy of the films on CD to keep in your binder- many physicians like to look at them in addition to the report and it will save you an additional trip. It may be helpful to add a pocket to your binder to keep the result reports and scans on CD handy. Always follow up for results- do not assume results are fine if you do not hear, things can fall through the cracks.
